I find a lightly creamed fruit character on the nose here, with scents of pressed apple and pear, lemon salt and a touch of mint. The palate is delightfully fresh and balanced, with a gentle texture, a vibrant acid profile, and a real sense of vigour. Pithy and grippy, this is quite delicious, although I suspect – thinking back to prior vintages – it will be best drunk young, in order to catch all that texture and pithy fruit. Well done.
